

Sicily & Malta: Cultural Crossroads of the Mediterranean April 15 – May 1, 2025

The Rocky Mountaineers will be traveling with Grand Circle Travel (GCT) on their *Sicily & Malta: Cultural Crossroads of the Mediterranean* adventure in the spring of 2025. The base trip departs the US on April 15 and returns on May 1, 2025.

Trip accommodations include: six nights in Valletta, Malta; three nights in Acireale, Italy; two nights in Agrigento, Italy; and four nights in Palermo, Italy. All breakfasts, 6 lunches, and 8 dinners are included. An optional pre-trip to Tunisia and/or post-trip in Rome are available. Per person prices are:

- \$3,895 for the 17-day base tour (April 15 - May 1, 2025)
- \$1,550 for air transportation from Denver (price may vary slightly from other cities)
- \$1,395 for the optional 7-night pre-trip to Tunisia (departs April 8, 2025)
- \$1,695 for the optional 4-night post-trip in Rome (returns May 5, 2025)
- Early payment discount of up to 10% is available when paying by ACH or check
- A group rebate of approximately 10% will be disbursed to travelers after the trip if we have 11 or more travelers in our group (we currently have 14 people registered).

- Let the representative know if you want to include air transportation (you will be responsible for your transportation between the airport and hotel if you provide your own air), or if you want to take the pre-trip to Tunisia, and/or the post-trip in Rome.
- Deposit \$350 per person (recommend paying with ACH to maximize your discount if you plan to pay in full early).
- GCT will recommend purchasing their Travel Protection Plan (travel insurance is recommended, although less expensive plans may be available through InsureMyTrip.com or other third parties).
